

The regular meeting of the Richfield Town Board was held via Zoom Meeting on Monday, May 18, 2020. The meeting was opened by Supervisor Palevsky at 7:03 pm. Board members in attendance at the start of the meeting were, Eckler and Frigault. Councilman Bello joined the meeting at 7:22 pm; Councilman Seamon joined the meeting at 7:30 pm. Highway Superintendent Proctor and Clerk Young were in attendance.

Motion by Eckler to pay all claims with three signatures, second by Palevsky. Eckler-yes, Frigault-yes, Palevsky-yes.

The Clerk opened sealed paving bids from Cobleskill Stone Products, Inc, Barrett Paving Materials Inc, and Hanson Aggregates NY, LLC. Hanson Aggregates NY, LLC had the lowest bid, however with CHIPS money in question, the board tabled awarding a winning bid at the time of the meeting. The board needs more clarity on funding before a decision for the 2020 paving can take place.

The Board had a discussion on the opening of Bakers Beach. At this time the Town does not have an operating permit from the DOH. A sample of the water supply was taken; the results are expected to be in soon. Councilman Bello will update the board on the results of the water when they come back.

The board had a discussion on holding a special meeting on June 1, 2020 at the Town Garage to discuss outstanding town business.

Supervisor Palevsky contacted JCAP in regards to reapportioning the grant money that was awarded to the court. If they town wants to reapportion the grant money, the court will need to reapply.

The board had a discussion on removing one of the Judges from the ballot in November.

Motion by Eckler to accept the April 20, 2020 minutes, second by Palevsky. Bello-yes, Eckler-yes, Frigault-abstain, Seamon-yes, Palevsky-yes.

Motion by Eckler to adjourn at 8:06 pm, second by Palevsky. All members were in favor.
